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### **INTRODUCTION**

This guide explains how to replace the hard drive in your Lenovo Legion. You may be replacing a fried hard drive or you may be upgrading memory. A hard drive can also be removed in order to put a solid state drive in place.


## TOOLS:

Spudger (1) Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)

## PARTS:

Crucial MX500 1 TB SSD (1) Crucial MX500 250 GB SSD (1) Crucial MX500 500 GB SSD (1) 2 TB SSD (1) 5H20J35762 - Lenovo Laptop Hard Drive - Genuine (1) 01FR402 - Lenovo Laptop Hard Drive -Genuine (1)

#### Step 1 — Hard Drive



• Remove the thirteen 6.5 mm screws from the bottom of the laptop using a Phillips #00 screwdriver.

#### Step 2




- Flip the laptop on its side and use a spudger or a credit card to pry the bottom covering off. To get a better grip you may want to open the laptop slightly.
- The bottom piece will make popping noises as it is pulled from the laptop.
- When reassembling make sure that the bottom piece clicks back into place on all sides of the laptop.

#### Step 3



- The hard drive is a white square located on the right side of your device.
- Use a Phillips #00 screwdriver to remove four 4.0 mm screws holding the hard drive in place.

## Step 4



- Slide the hard drive from the device towards your right.
- When reinstalling remember to slide the hard drive in from the right. Don't try to force it in from the front.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
