INTRODUCTION

This guide details the removal and installation of the external power and volume buttons located on the right edge of the back cover.



TOOLS:

- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- Spudger (1)
- T5 Torx Screwdriver (1)



PARTS:

- Nexus 4 (GSM) Volume Button (1)
- Nexus 4 (GSM) Power Button (1)

Step 1 — Back Cover





- Power off the phone, by long-pressing the power button and touching *Power off.*
- Remove the SIM tray using the <u>SIM Card Eject Tool</u>.
- This step is required in order to remove the back case.

Step 2



 Remove the two screws from the bottom of the phone with a <u>T5 Torx</u> <u>Screwdriver</u>.

Step 3







- Gently open the back case by prying along the edge of the cover, starting at a corner of the phone and circling around the phone using a plastic opening tool.
- (i) The opening process may take a few minutes. The plastic will make a light snapping noise as the back cover separates from the rest of the phone.

Step 4 — Power and Volume Button





 Holding the back case, gently push the power button in towards the center of the phone using a spudger.

• To remove the volume button, push the button in towards the center of the phone using a spudger.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
