INTRODUCTION

The trucks on a Penny board are an essential part of the board. They can get damaged in a variety of ways, which can lead to an unpleasant riding experience. Whether they get worn down or completely broken, they will need a replacement. Luckily, this repair is pretty simple so one can get back to skating in no time. For this repair, a skate tool will be required.

Step 1 — Trucks




- Use a skate tool to loosen the bolt in the wheel with an appropriately sized socket.
- ⓘ A skate tool will come with all the tools necessary to do this replacement from start to finish.

Step 2



- Remove the wheel by lifting it from the truck.
- Repeat this step for the other wheel.

Step 3



i After completing the removal of both wheels, your board will look like this.

- Place the skate tool over the bolt on the truck.
- Maintain a good grip on the tool and use the Phillips screwdriver to loosen the nuts.
- Repeat this step for all four screws.

Step 4



- Lift the truck to remove it.

Step 5



- Remove the screws from the board by pulling them out with your hands.
- ⓘ Use the Phillips screwdriver to loosen them more, if necessary.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
