

How to Repair a Hole in Cotton Winter Gloves by Hand-Sewing

INTRODUCTION

Do you have a hole in your winter gloves?

Then this will be a great guide to follow. This guide will teach you how to fix your gloves with a needle and thread by hand sewing.

Follow the instructions below to restore your winter gloves.



TOOLS:

- Sewing Scissors (1)
- Hand Sewing Needle (1)
- Sewing Thread (1)

Step 1 — Cotton Winter Gloves





Find the hole in your glove.

Step 2



- Using sewing scissors, cut away any loose thread or frayed sections.
- Removing loose thread or frayed sections will help the sewing process be easier.




- Turn the glove inside out.
- it will ensure that the stitching from the repair won't be seen on the outside.

Step 4





 Cut about 24 inches of thread with a color that matches your gloves.



- Hold the needle with your thumb and index finger.
- Insert one end of the thread into the eye of the needle.
- Pull the thread through the needle about halfway.
- Morking with sewing needles can potentially result in a minor injury.

Step 6





- Find both ends of the thread.
- Line the ends of the thread together.
- Create a knot at the end of the thread.



- Using your dominant hand, insert the needle as close to the edge of the hole as possible.
- Pull the needle and all of the thread through the glove.

Step 8





- Thread the needle to the other side of the glove to create a straight stitch.
- Repeat steps 7 and 8 until you reach the other end of the hole.
- (i) How to Sew a Straight Stitch



 Insert 3/4 of the needle into the glove.

Step 10



Wrap the thread around the needle 3 times.



 Pull the needle and thread through to make a knot.

Step 12



Cut the excess thread off.



Turn the glove around and wear the glove!

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
