
• Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Opening the Device



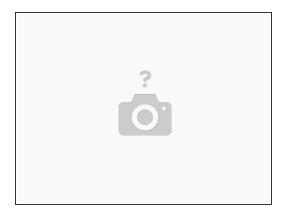
 Flip device upside down and remove the 4 foam pads at each corner.

Step 2



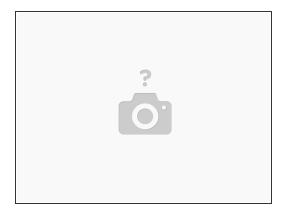
• Remove the 4 screws using a Philips Screwdriver.

Step 3



• Gently lift the case off of the body and set down in a safe place.

Step 4 — Repairing AcuRite Intelli-Time Alarm Clock Unresponsive Buttons




Unscrew Circuit board attached to the top of the case with the one screw in the center. Be careful
not to strip the screw/break the circuit board.

Step 5



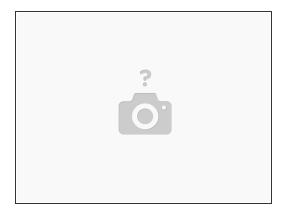
 Make sure all of the buttons are move-able.

Step 6



Press buttons on circuit board while listening for a click.

Step 7



• If everything works on the inside, that might mean you need a new circuit board.
