

Nokia 8260 Antenna Replacement

INTRODUCTION

How to remove the gold patch antenna.



Step 1 — Battery



• Turn off the cell phone.

Step 2



• Press down on the round button on the back cover of the phone.

Step 3



• Slide the back cover down while still pressing the button.

Step 4



• Remove the back cover.

Step 5



• Press the end of the battery towards the top of the phone.

Step 6



- Lift the battery outwards while still pressing it upwards till it pops out.
- (i) You may need to take several attempts to lift out the battery.

Step 7 — Antenna



- Squeeze the flat end of the spudger into the crack right under the word "Nokia" on the back of the phone.
- (i) This step may be a bit difficult if you are removing the antenna for the first time.

Step 8



• Pry open the antenna door by pulling down the top of the spudger

Step 9



• Remove the antenna door.

Step 10



- If the gold antenna remained stuck to the door, you have finished removing the antenna from the phone.
- If the gold antenna is still in the phone, carefully remove it and stick it onto the back of the door.
- Try to keep the antenna as flat as possible. Do not bend it.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
