

Nokia 6102i Keyboard Replacement

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INTRODUCTION

Removing the keyboard from the Nokia 6102i



TOOLS:

- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- T6 Torx Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Battery







- Press and hold the button at the bottom of the back side of the phone while sliding the back plate down to remove the back cover.
- Note: Images on the right side may be hovered over to reveal larger versions.

Step 2



- Lift up the battery from the inside of the phone.
- (i) Make sure to lift up from the bottom of the battery as shown.

Step 3 — Logic Board





Using a .208 head <u>T-6 Screwdriver</u> remove the two screws at the bottom of the battery cavity.


Step 4





- Use a plastic opening tool to remove the silver cover over the antenna.
- The covering may not pop right off. It may require some prying in different locations around the top covering.

Step 5






Remove the two newly revealed .208 inch screws at the top using a T-6 screwdriver.

Step 6







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- WARNING: Use extreme caution when removing and handling the logic board as it is very fragile.
- With caution, use a plastic prier to separate the back silver casing from the front of the phone. This
 may require force.
- Disconnect the logic board from the small orange chip.

Step 7 — Keyboard





- Pop out the keyboard from the frame.
- Once the logic board is removed, the keypad can be easily popped out from the frame with very little force.
- The picture is showing the three layers: the frame, the keyboard, and the logic board.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
