

# **TOOLS:**

- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- T6 Torx Screwdriver (1)
- Spudger (1)

## Step 1 — Front panel/ Screen Logic Board



- Using the plastic opening tool, pry off the top faceplate.
- Place the tool in the small crack that runs along the side of the phone and pry.

## Step 2




 Using the T6 Torx Screwdriver remove all 4 small screws.

# Step 3




Remove silver plate from phone.

# Step 4




 Using the spudger remove the plastic camera casing

## Step 5




 Using the iPod Opening Tool remove the yellow flex cable from the green logic board.

# Step 6




 Use Spudger or hands to detach flex cable from front screen logic board

## Step 7 — Small LCD Display Screen




 Use a plastic opening tool to lift the small black flap to unlock the screen from the motherboard.

# Step 8



 Using your fingers, carefully pull out the small LCD display screen.

# Step 9



 Remove the small LCD display screen completely from the green logic board.
