INTRODUCTION


To replace your bulletproof cover that apparently wasn't so life proof.




TOOLS:

• iFixit Opening Tools (1)

Step 1 — Taking off the Back Cover






- Remove the SIM card.
- Remove the microSD card.
- Insert the plastic opening tool between the back cover and the front piece of the case, freeing the plastic clips between the phone.
- Do this along the back right side of the phone cover until you reach the top.

Step 2





- Use the plastic opening tool to carefully work your way around the top of the phone, freeing the plastic clips.
- ⚠ Be cautious when using the tool around the top of the device because the plastic case is very thin and could easily be cracked or snapped.
- Continue using the tool and pry down the remaining side and the bottom of the phone.

Step 3







- With all the plastic clips released, pull away the back cover from the phone to remove it.
- (i) The back cover is attached to the battery with a large amount of adhesive. Some force may be required to pull the back cover from the phone.
- (i) The back cover is very durable and will not break from some bending or pulling.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
