INTRODUCTION

If your phone's motherboard needs to be replaced, this guide will assist you through the replacement steps.

TOOLS:

Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1) iFixit Opening Tool (1) Tweezers (1)

Step 1 — Battery



- Set the phone screen down on a clean flat, surface.
- Insert the plastic opening tool into the groove located between the body of the phone, and the back plate protecting the battery.
- Open the back of the device by prying around the sides of the back panel using the plastic opening tool.

Step 2




- Insert the plastic opening tool in between the battery and the phone body.
- Pry up on the side of battery, and remove it.

Step 3 — Motherboard



 Remove the bottom cover of the phone using the plastic opening tool.

Step 4




 Remove the five 5.47mm and one 5.18mm Torx head screws using a Phillips #0 screwdriver.

Step 5




 Carefully remove the back cover using the plastic opening tool.

Step 6



 Pry up on the right side of the motherboard using the plastic opening tool.

Step 7



• Carefully detach the flex cable using a pair of <u>tweezers</u>.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
