

INTRODUCTION


Taking off the outer panels of your camera, disconnecting and replacing the mini USB port.



TOOLS:


- Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)
- iFixit Opening Tools (1)

Step 1 — Mini USB Port




 Remove screw attaching the Mini USB Cover to the top of the camera body.

Step 2



 Remove Mini USB Cover, by pulling it away from the camera body.

Step 3



- Detach electronic ribbon and Mini USB Port using a plastic opening tool to pull the ribbon off.
 - You can now replace the Mini USB Port.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
