

iHome iP41BR Ipod Adapter Replacement

Replace the iPod adapter on your iHome iP41BR

TOOLS:

- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)
- Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)
- Metal Spudger (optional) (1)

Step 1 — Remove Phillips Screws



Remove the two 8mm Phillips #0 screws from the iHome's iPod adapter.


Step 2 — Pull Out iPod Adapter






- Use the metal spudger to loosen the edges of the plastic cover.
- Pull the adapter up and away from the housing, rotating it forward slightly as you lift it so the top faces you.

Step 3



- Pull firmly on the red and black cable connector to disconnect it.
- Pinch the ribbon cable on both sides and pull it firmly to disconnect it.
 - The ribbon cable takes a bit more force to disconnect than the red and black cable. Make sure to pull evenly on the entire cable for ease of removal.


Step 4 — Remove Plastic Cover





 Remove the four 7mm Phillips #00 screws attaching the black plastic cover to the bottom of the adapter assembly.

Step 5



 Pull the ipod adapter out of the plastic holder ad replace.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
